- **6.7.** In respect of Candidates who are currently in services, shall submit the "No Objection Certificate" from the Employer when called for the personal interview.

7. Selection Process:

- **7.1.** There will be written/assignment and personal interview for the positions. Written test will comprise of Subject Matter Knowledge, General Knowledge, Reasoning, and English.
- 7.2. The Written Test/ Personal Interview will be held only in Shillong.

8. General Information:

- **8.1.** The pre-requisite qualifications and experience are minimal and the mere fact that a candidate possesses the same will not entitle him/her for being called for interview. MBDA reserves the right to restrict the candidates to be called for interview to a reasonable number on the basis of qualifications and experience higher than the minimum prescribed in the advertisement or by any other condition that it may deem fit.
- **8.2.** Candidates are advised to clearly indicate their contact number and e-mail address to facilitate faster communication. Information regarding the screening test/written/interview will be sent only to the shortlisted candidates via SMS/E-mail and no correspondence will be made with applicants who are not shortlisted.
