Engagement of Climate Expert on Contractual Basis (Full Time)

Small Industries Development Bank of India (SIDBI) was established on April 2, 1990 under an act of Indian Parliament. It is the principal financial institution for the promotion, financing and development of Micro, Small & Medium Enterprises (MSMEs). Over the years, SIDBI has evolved itself as a one-stop institution to meet the various types of credit requirements of the MSME sector by offering specialized fund based and non-fund based financial products. Also, besides being a purveyor of credit, the Bank endeavours to fulfil its developmental mandate by providing policy inputs to the Government of India as well as introducing innovative solutions, technology and processes for developing the MSME ecosystem in India. In keeping with the spirit of innovation and entrepreneurship, the Bank has also evolved its bouquet of offerings over the years. One such focus area is financing of energy efficient, green technologies and climate aligned green projects, as also non-financial interventions in this space. These also offer a tremendous opportunity for the banking sector.

SIDBI is implementing several green, clean, sustainable development initiatives with a mission of “Greening the Enterprise Ecosystem”. SIDBI has setup a dedicated “Green Climate Finance Vertical” at New Delhi which is implementing various developmental theme projects in Green space in close coordination with various national and international agencies / stakeholders, bilateral / multilateral institutions / agencies viz. The World Bank, KfW, AfD, GiZ, ADB, BEE, EESL, JICA, etc. SIDBI is also once of the Direct Access Entity (DAE) of Green Climate Fund (GCF) who has been designated as an operating entity of the financial mechanism under Article 11 of the UNFCCC, was established as a Governing Instrument possessing juridical personality in order to operate effectively internationally. GCF resources are channelled through Accredited Entities nominated by the respective country’s National Designated Agency [NDA]. Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change [MoEF&CC], Government of India, is the NDA for India, and SIDBI is one of the Accredited Entities (AE) of GCF.

Now in order to take forward its “Green” agenda towards “Greening the Enterprise Ecosystem” and other green climate aligned enterprise promotion and development initiatives, aligned with SIDBI’s mandate and national priorities, SIDBI invites applications for the following position on contractual basis to assist in various activities / initiatives / projects / programmes being undertaken by it:

C.	No. of Posts	Three (03) – 01 OBC and 02 UR
D.	Period of Contract	The term of the contract would initially be for a period of one year , extendable, at sole discretion of the Bank, for a further period of up to two (02) year . The contract can be terminated at one months’ notice on either side or salary and allowances (if any) in lieu thereof.
E.	Qualification and Experience	a. Age limit The candidate should not be more than 45 years of age as on last date of submission. b. Educational Qualification <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Graduation in any discipline.

Remuneration	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Rs. 1 lakh to Rs. 2 lakh per month (all inclusive), based on experience/ profile of the candidate. • Annual increment of upto 10% of monthly remuneration, may also be considered by the Bank, based on performance. <p>No other payment shall be made except reimbursement of Travelling / Halting allowance / expenses, in case of outstation tours, as per norms of SIDBI and equivalent to the Manager (i.e. Grade – B officer) of the Bank.</p>
G.	Selection Procedure	<p>Selection would be by way of shortlisting and Personal Interview to be held "Online" (details would be shared to the shortlisted candidates) before the Selection Committee.</p> <p>The Bank will undertake a preliminary screening of the applications for preparing, if necessary, a shortlist of eligible candidates to be called for interview. Thus, merely fulfilling the requirements laid down in the advertisement would not automatically entitle any candidate to be called for interview.</p>

H. Indicative Roles and responsibilities

1. The expert shall be attached on full time basis to Green Climate Finance Vertical of SIDBI at New Delhi or any other location at the discretion of SIDBI and will be responsible for increasing the portfolio of projects in the area of green climate, energy efficiency and sustainable development.
2. The expert shall explore potential engagement areas / projects in the area of green climate, energy efficiency and sustainable development and shall develop and formulate the ideas into actionable concept notes and funding proposals along-with financial and economic modelling, etc. in accordance with the requirements of SIDBI as well as other institutions / regulatory bodies / think tanks including multilateral and bilateral institutions.

3. The expert shall prepare the Terms of Reference (TORs), budgeting, work plan, etc. for various contracts to be awarded by the Vertical. The expert shall supervise and also provide written inputs into the various reports submitted by the Consultancy firms hired for baseline assessment, feasibility studies, impact assessment, best market practices, etc.
4. The expert shall be responsible for implementation, supervision, monitoring, evaluation and reporting of technical, operational and financial aspects of the projects undertaken by the Vertical. The expert shall be responsible for ensuring compliance with Standards, Policies and Procedures of projects undertaken by the Vertical as per the requirement of the concerned donor agency.
5. The expert shall be responsible for developing and putting in place an effective Management Information System (MIS) mechanism for reporting the progress, record keeping to the senior management of SIDBI. at regular intervals as well as ensuring proper record keeping. The expert shall analyse various progress reports as against the envisaged deliverables as also the overall Project Objectives and shall submit comments along-with suggestions for improvements / corrective actions required, if any.
6. The expert shall be able to identify, analyze and properly document the benefits as well as environmental, social and other impacts of the projects.
7. The expert shall be actively involved in awareness creation, training and capacity building activities to the MSMEs / Banks / FIs / NBFCs officials including SIDBI employees, other partners and stakeholders and shall also develop suitable training modules / workshop material for the same.
8. The expert should have expertise in drafting and developing project reports, research papers, talking points, conference /seminar proceedings, compendium, etc.
9. The expert should have expertise in developing theme presentation for the benefit of variety of stakeholders including govt. officials, bilateral / multilateral institutions, international agencies actively involved in the field of Climate Change, Green Finance, Sustainable Development Goals, etc.
10. Any other responsibility assigned from time to time.

Applications should be accompanied by self-attested copies of relevant certificate(s) / documents, in support of proof of identity, address, age, educational qualification (educational certificates/mark-sheets), work experience, etc., as mentioned in the application form. An application not accompanied by photocopies/ scanned copies (in cases of applied online) of relevant certificate(s) / documents, or not in prescribed format or not signed by the candidate or incomplete in any respect or received after due date will not be entertained under any circumstances.

J. Others

1. The shortlisted candidates shall have to produce all **certificates in original** for verification of their age, educational qualification, experience details, etc. **at the time of interview / joining. Failure to produce the same shall render the candidate ineligible for the recruitment process.**
2. Candidates are advised that they should not furnish any particulars or information that are false, tampered/ fabricated or should not suppress any material information while applying for the post.
3. In case it is detected at any stage that a candidate does not fulfill any of the eligibility criteria for the post applied for and / or that he / she has furnished any incorrect information or has suppressed any material fact(s), his / her candidature will stand cancelled forthwith. If any of these shortcomings is / are detected even after the appointment, his/ her services will be liable to be terminated forthwith.
