About the project:

Mental health intervention aimed at increasing teachers' capacity for emotional safety in class-rooms.

This 2-year intervention seeks to equip 200 teachers in India with increased awareness about the role of psychosocial wellbeing in learning and the skills to adopt trauma-sensitive teaching approaches in their classrooms. Given that school-going children spend over 6 hours for at least five days a week in educational settings, there is immense scope for educators to create an environment conducive to learning, where students feel emotionally and physically safe irrespective of their home backgrounds. The main output of this intervention will be consistent evidence-based training and support check-ins for the selected teachers by a carefully curated group of mental health professionals. Training will cover topics such as the neurobiology of trauma, links between wellbeing and cognition, how to create emotional safety in classrooms, how to help students cope in healthy ways, among others. This project has the potential to positively disrupt the Indian educational sector, in that it could establish a successful case study for policy change to make mental health education part of both teachers' professional training and students' curricula. This project is funded by Flourishing Minds Foundation.

II. Roles and Responsibilities
